The II Biennial Conference of the Latin American Network of Translation and Interpretation Studies, "Spaces, maps and territories of Translation and Interpretation in Latin America" [ReLaETI2018] will take place from 17 to 20 September, 2018 at the School of Languages (Valparaíso, Ciudad Universitaria) of the National University of Córdoba (Argentina).

The ReLaETI2018 is jointly organized by the chair of "Introduction to Translation Studies" and the research group "Studies on Total Translation".

#### **Abstract Guidelines and Submssion**

#### **GUIDELINES**

If you would like to participate in round-table discussions or present a book, you should submit your abstract in the **ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM**.

For round-table discussions or research group presentations, the following section sequence is recommended:

- 1- theoretical framework
- 2- study problem
- 3- hypothesis
- 4- methodology and procedures
- 5- findings or conclusions.

For research group presentations, and to improve the schedule organization, <u>only one form</u> including the information of its members (director and members) should be submitted. Moreover, so as to balance the time assigned to oral presentations, up to 5 members should be included.

For book presentations, the following section sequence is suggested:



- 1- development of the "book" project
- 2- its preparation
- 3- description of the editorial project
- 4- impact on recipient communities
- 5- additional expectations

There will be two deadlines for abstract submission: May 30th and June 15th.

# Additional considerations:

- 1. Up to two authors will be accepted per presentation proposal.
- 2. Up to two presentations are allowed per author.
- 3. The presentation can be in any of the languages taught at the FL UNC (German, Spanish, French, English, Italian and Portuguese).
- 4. You must complete both the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM and the Conference Registration Form in the links at the Conference website.

Abstracts should be submitted in the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM, to congresorelaeti2018@gmail.com before either of the above mentioned deadlines.
